## **ATTENTION: HEAVY TRUCK OWNERS**

This notice is to alert you that the <u>NEW</u> 2290 HEAVY HIGHWAY VEHICLE USE TAX RETURN must be completed and mailed to the IRS for any vehicle(s) registered over 54,000 pounds, this 2290 is due to the IRS by <u>NOVEMBER 30, 2011.</u> In future years it will be due August 31.

After mailing the 2290 Heavy Vehicle Use Return, the IRS will return a stamped copy to you. The stamped 2290 form will be submitted to the County Treasurer when you purchase your heavy truck registration renewal(s) from January 1 to February 28 of each year. If you file by mail you will not be charged a fee for a suspended truck. (Suspended tax: 5,000 miles regular use 7,500 miles Ag use) You must put the VIN of your truck(s) on Schedule 1, Part I and enter the number of vehicles in Part II b. Mailing address: Internal Revenue Service, Cincinnati Ohio 4599-0031.

JULY 2011) IN THE UPPER LEFT HAND CORNER!! IT IS FOR THE PERIOD JULY 1, 2011 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2012.

You may access the following web site if you would like to file online. The online company <u>will</u> <u>charge</u> a fee even if you are filing suspended tax. If filing online you will receive an emailed stamped 2290 and you can have the IRS fax a copy to the Treasurer's Office. **Web site:** <u>www.irs2290.com</u>

The County Treasurer's Office can <u>NO LONGER COMPLETE THE 2290 FORM FOR YOU!!!</u> On a new vehicle purchase, you will have 60 days to file. Also, **even if you are an individual**, you <u>MUST</u> have an Employer Identification Number (EIN). *You can no longer use your Social Security Number!* To obtain and EIN see page 5 of the 2290 form.
